

## DAY SIX: THE CHRISTMAS BANQUET

Even if you have read Psalm 23 over and over, start today by reading it again, taking into consideration the Christmas banquet described in today's devotion.

How do these words relate to you right now?

Beginning in verse 5, a table is prepared, for David, and for you. There is no mention you need a ticket or money for this banquet, just come as you are.

Guests in David's day would be anointed with oil for refreshment and given a glass of choice wine, which hosts would fill until it ran over to imply while they remained there, they would have an abundance.

He wants you to be filled to the brim in every way with every good thing.

Read Isaiah 55:1-3.

List the three drinks that are mentioned in these verses and what needs each drink may fill.

How much do these drinks cost?

What does it warn against in verse 2?

Verse 3 says, "Incline your ear, and come to me; hear, that your soul may live;" You might think of it this way, "Lean in close to Me so you can hear My life-giving, life-nourishing words."

Zephaniah 3:17 tells of how your God, the Creator of the universe, sings over you. How amazing!

Lean in close, hear His words He has chosen for you, and be filled with LIFE!
